



Chainsaw Maintenance, Cross-Cutting, Felling and Processing Trees up to 380mm

Days / Times 5 days, usually Mon-Fri. Start at 8.30 on Monday.

Venue Venue varies in either the North or South Lakes, and will be decided on a course by course basis.

Assessment On a separate date following the course, to be arranged with your trainer directly.

Equipment **You will need your own chainsaw, personal protective equipment and suitable outdoor clothing.**

Please bring the following:

- Helmet, less than 5 yrs old
- Chainsaw boots
- Chainsaw gloves
- Chainsaw trousers, type A (front protection only) or type C (all round)
- Personal first aid kit
- Chainsaw in good safe condition with a guide bar up to 15" 380mm(16" ok)
- Petrol and Oil

Any maintenance/ sharpening tools you may have

Please bring the following IF YOU HAVE THEM:

- Maintenance and sharpening tools for your saw
- Felling bar
- Hammer and wedges
- Timber tongs or pulp hook

Meal breaks Please bring a packed lunch and flask with you each day. We provide tea and coffee on the first day, which will be classroom based.

Weather In the event of exceptionally poor or dangerous weather conditions it may become impossible to continue working in the woods. It is your instructor's responsibility to ensure your safety. If this happens, your instructor will make every effort to replace on-site training with other relevant maintenance or safety training in an appropriate safe or under-cover area.
